Dear Mr. Landry, this message concerns your decision on how to deal with healthcare and health insurance in the United States. Regarding health insurance and the distribution of healthcare, everybody should receive a baseline of treatment. This includes general doctors' appointments, simple tests, and vaccinations. Medications, depending on how necessary they are for a citizen, will be paid for by the user, but through insurance, they will not pay the full price. However, if it is an OTC drug, the full price will be required. Any other form of treatment will require payment, but depending on the insurance plan of the citizen, they will not be required to pay the full price unless the treatment is not covered by their plan. This plan is made in order to help the people who can't pay for things like healthcare, by offering standard treatment to them without a cost. If a citizen requires immediate and/or emergency care, they will be given an appropriate amount of time and resources in order to pay back the price they need to. All healthcare providers will also be required to follow strict rules, which will be stated in a later conference. In order to pay for this policy, taxes will be raised only slightly, but this policy will prove to be beneficial. Harvard research has shown that there are as many as 44,000 deaths that are related to a lack of healthcare.
